Difficulty Rating - The difficulty ratings were established by taking into account the elevation gain and/or loss of the leg (40%), the length of the leg (40%) and other variables including but not limited to: time of day runner/walker will be on the course, type of road surface and congestion/rural nature of the area (20%). The ratings are highly subjective and correspond to an approximate 10% increase in difficulty from one rating to the next. (E - Easy. M - Moderate. H -Hard. VH - Very Hard.)



Peak Symbol - The "Peak" symbol is used to identify those legs of the course that a reasonable person would regard as "scenic" and/or "beautiful." Although many conversations have been had about what actually constitutes as "scenic" and/or "beautiful," the end result is a somewhat telling example of the diverse beauty and splendor of Oregon.



Directional Sign (on course) - When you come to an intersection and there are no arrow signs, you should continue straight. When there is an intersection where you should turn, you will see this directional BBC arrow.

Route - Running route shown as red line, mile markers as large white circle, and tenth mile markers as white dots. **Please pay attention to instructions to run on the LEFT or RIGHT side of the road as instructed.** We have runners on the LEFT whenever possible. However, due to traffic patterns (for example, cars drive slower uphill than downhill), safety concerns, and exchange point locations, **please follow our "Touch and Go" instructions.**


Follow the "Touch and Go" instructions by running to each directional sign, physically touch the sign, and follow the directional arrow in order to be on the correct side of the road. We will place all directional signs on the side of the road that you should be running on. It becomes extremely unsafe when participants are on both sides of the road; therefore, teams will be disqualified and asked to leave the course if they are seen on the wrong side of the road




Van Route - On some legs of the race, Vans are required to follow a diffe ent route than that shown for the runner/ walker. When this occurs the Van Route is depicted using an orange dashed line. Inactive Vans shall follow the Route Maps as indicated for Inactive Vans.



The Bend Beer Chase is an OPEN ROAD event. Roads are not closed for this event. All road crossings must be at crosswalks and designated pedestrian crossings, and all participants shall adhere to pedestrian rules of the road. Participation in this event is at your own risk and liability. Race vans/vehicles must follow all rules of the road. Race vans shall only pull over in a designated pull- out or side road. Race vans shall never pull off on the side of the oad where all tires are not safely on the other side of the white line, and shall never block a bike lane.



Notes:


Vans will not follow the runner once they turn right (north) onto NE Hunnel Road, but will need to route around construction via either Empire Ave or Robal Rd to Hwy 20 and then back onto Old Bend/RDM Hwy to arrive at Schillings Market.

Runner Direction:

- 0.0 START 10 Barrel Brewing
- 1.6 LEFT Lava Ridge sports field onto path
- 1.9 MERGE onto Cooley Road and use crosswalk to be on North side of Cooley Rd
- 2.4 CROSS US-97 at traffic signal
- 2.6 RIGHT NE Hunnel Rd
- 3.0 STRAIGHT road becomes unimproved jeep trail
- 4.0 LEFT Rogers Road (run on right side)
- 4.5 RIGHT- Old Bend Redmond Hwy (run on right side)
- 6.2 RIGHT– Enter Schillings Market
- 6.3 FINISH Schilling's Garden Market

Van Direction :

- 0.0 START 10 Barrel Brewing
- 1.7 LEFT Take 3rd exit at roundabout to go west on Cooley Road
- 2.5 STRAIGHT Cross US-97 at traffic light
- 2.9 LEFT NW Hunnel Road (just past Les Schwab at road closure)
- 3.3 RIGHT NW Robal Ln
- 3.6 RIGHT Take 1st exit onto US Hwy 20 (W) towards Sisters
- 4.7 RIGHT Take 1st exit onto Old Bend Redmond Hwy
- 6.8 RIGHT Enter Schillings Garden Market


Description :


Notes:

Runners are encouraged to carry water on this leg as the final four miles of this leg are unsupported. Follow the pink flags to remain on the trail. If in doubt on the trail - stay to your right towards the Cline Falls Highway.








Ovid William Brockett Riley, an early Bend pioneer, was a native of Ohio who came west from Kansas with his parents in 1893, at age 18, according to historic newspaper accounts. His family lived in a log cabin on the Deschutes River and by 1908, Riley already had a local road named for him — Ovid W.B. Riley Road.


It's not clear when it happened, but sometime after 1914, the road's name shortened to O.B. Riley. How's that for a random fact!



Description:


The final competitive leg of the Bend Beer Chase is capstoned by the beauty and peaceful serenity of the Deschutes River Trail. At the end of this leg, take a breather and then enjoy kicking off the Keg Leg with your teammates!

Notes:

Vans will depart for downtown Bend along a different route to arrive downtown for the conclusion of the competitive part of BBC.

Runner Directions:

- 0.0 DEPART Shilo Inns Bend (Ex. Pt. 11)
- 0.1 LEFT onto trail to enter Sawyer Park
- 0.1 RIGHT onto trail to enter Sawyer Park
- 0.3 CROSS over Deschutes River at Sawyer Park Bridge
- 0.3 RIGHT after crossing river, follow Trail (grass field on your left)
- 0.6 LEFT Follow Deschutes River Trail south (DRT)
- 1.0 CROSS NW Mount Washington at Crosswalk
- 1.0 RIGHT NW Mount Washington Dr.
- 1.2 LEFT Deschutes River Trail
- 1.9 LEFT Cross over Deschutes River at 1st Street Rapids Bridge
- 1.9 RIGHT after crossing bridge to stay on DRT through Pioneer Park
- 2.1 CROSS NW Portland Ave (at pedestrian crosswalk)
- 2.2 STRAIGHT into Pacific Park (keep the river on your right shoulder)
- 2.4 SLIGHT RIGHT to join the newly constructed River Trail
- 2.5 STRAIGHT under Newport Ave Bridge (keep river on your right shoulder)
- 2.8 ARRIVE Drake Park (FINISH)




